ORDER

Read the averments made in the complaint and the report received from Respondent Commissioner of Police, Nashik. Read the case papers.

2. The complainant resides in a house situated behind Highway ST bus Stand, Nashik. Thousands of persons daily come on this Bus Stand. The ST department has affixed speakers at number of places on the ST Stand for giving



instructions to the ST drivers and conductors and for giving information to the passengers. It was alleged that these speakers are continuously used through out the day and night and it caused great nuisance to the persons residing in that locality. Secondly, the ST employees and hundreds of passenger use the land in front of house of complainant as a toilet and thus, they create dirty and unhygienic atmosphere in that area. Therefore, he moved the Commission for necessary action in this matter.

3. The Respondent Commissioner Mahanagar Palika, Nashik by filing their reply informed which action they have already taken in this matter. According to them they always clean the area. Even the ST Department affixed board and did not allow people to use that land as a toilet etc. and always keeps watch on the situation.

4. Commissioner of Police, Nashik in their Report did mention that the announcement on the speakers is necessary for the convenience of the passengers and staff members. Moreover, this system is working between 6.00 a.m. to 21.00 p.m. About other nuisance, according to Commissioner of Police, Nashik, the Corporation and ST Department have taken proper action accordingly. In short according to Commissioner of Police, Nashik there is no substance into the allegations made in the complaint.

5. There cannot be any dispute on the point that the speaker system is operated for the convenience of the passengers and staff members. The Report shows that this system is operated during day time i.e. from 6.00 a.m. to 21.00 p.m. The house of the complainant is situated adjacent to the ST stand. The reply filed by the Corporation shows that the speakers are situated at such place, so that the complainant and other residents would get minimum sound nuisance. Thus, the ST Department has taken precaution, so that the residents would get minimum nuisance. It is expected from ST Department to operate the speakers with such volume, so that the residents would get minimum sound nuisance.

6. The reply filed by Corporation shows that Corporation and ST Department have already taken sufficient efforts to stop the other nuisance of open latrine. The Commission hopes and trusts that Mahanagar Palika, Nashik and ST Department Nashik would work together and see that such nuisance is completely stopped and ^{not} repeated in future.

With these observations and suggestions the Case No. 1781/2008-09 is disposed of accordingly.
