ORDER

Complainant Dossa Mohd Hanif with victims mother Mrs. Rizwan Shahid Sayeed as well as PSI, Shri Surendra A. Pawar, Meghwadi Police station are present. Complainant is a social worker and supposed to be the General Secretary of the so called NGO named the National Security & Anti Corruption Crime Preventive Brigade, Bldg.8/A Wing, FlatNo.305, Amrut, Jogeshwari(W), Mumbai. Smt. Rizwana Shaid Sayyad is the mother of the victim who narrated the incidence dated 15.09.2011 and ventilated her grievance that her complaint was not taken by PSI, Shri Parab of Meghwadi police station who was present at that time. However after persuasion the case was registered by Meghwadi Police station vide Cr. No. 264/2011 u/s. 354, 506 (2), IPC on 09.11.2011. Case has been chargesheeted on 02.03.2012 in the JMFC Railway Mumbai Court and it is pending trial. The delay in registration is of almost for 2 months.

Complaint of molestation was not registered immediately by police. Shri A.S.Parab, PSI then attached to Meghwadi Police Station failed to perform his duty. When the grievance was brought to the notice of the senior officers that time offence was registered by another PSI, Shri Surendra Pawar. Dossa Mohd. Haniff who is the complainant in this case has submitted an application dated 10.11.2014 stating that now local police has taken proper action after raising the clamour .

It is now clear that PSI, Shri A.S.Parab has failed to take proper cognizance of the complaint and refused to give proper response to the mother of the victim when she approached him to lodge the complaint of molestation.

Recommendation

It is very clear that PSI, Shri A.S.Parab has failed to register the cognizable case at that time. Hence necessary disciplinary action to be taken against him for his default. Inform the Additional Chief Secretary (Home) for taking necessary action.

With this recommendation the case is ordered to be close.
