## NOTIFICATION

PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS ACT, 1993.

No. SHRC. 0109/OR-22/PB-2/Pol.-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 read with clause (b) of sub-section (2) and sub-section (3) of section 27 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 (10 of 1994), the Government of Maharashtra hereby, makes the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission (Recruitment and General Service Conditions) Rules, 2017, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission (Recruitment and General Service Conditions)(Amendment) Rules, 2018.

2. In the Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission (Recruitment and General Service Conditions) Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), in the Preamble, for the words " Research Officer;" the words " Training Officer " shall be substituted.

3. For rule 5 of the principal Rules, the following rule shall be substituted namely:—

"5. Appointment to the post of Training Officer shall be made by inviting application from amongst the candidates who,—

(a) are not more than forty years of age ;

Provided that the upper age may be relaxed upto five years in case of candidates having minimum five years' experience as practicing Advocate ; and

(b) possess a degree in Law."
