मानिपाडा विभागात आम्रपाली गृहनिर्माण सोसायटी, गुडलक हाउस, संगम, खैनी टॉवर, ज्वेल टॉवर, पार्क वे, रेड रोज, सुजाता अपार्टमेंट अशा १२ ते १४ मजल्यांच्या इमारती आहेत.

आम्रपाली गृहनिर्माण सोसायटीच्या प्रवेशद्वारावर भर रस्त्यात महानगरपालिका मलनिस्सारण वाहिनी आठ ठिकाणी तुडुंब भरली जाते आणि त्यातील मैल व गटाराचे पाणी भररस्त्यात जमा होते. दरम्यान, या संदर्भात पालिका एच.पूव प्रभाग सहायक आयुक्तांना फोनवर संपर्क साधला. मात्र, त्यांनी फोन स्वीकारला नाही.

PROCEEDING

Not on board. Taken on board.

1. We noticed news appeared in Marathi News Paper Lokmat "Hello Mumbai" dated 07.01.2023 on Page 2 with heading "जागोजागी मैल्याची डबकी अन गटाराचे पाणी ; ३५ हजार रहिवाशांचे जगणेही मुश्कील".

2. It is stated in the said news article that Corporation failed and neglected to take appropriate steps to prevent the leakage from drainage and because of that more than 35,000 people are suffering.

3. It is also stated in the article that Mr. Narendra Butola, President of Amrapali Griha Nirman Society, Good Luck House, Sangam, Khaini Tower, Jewal Tower, Park Way Road Rose, Sujata Apartment made several complaints but nothing is happened.

4. Considering the said article appeared in Marathi Newspaper ~~dated~~ Lokmat "Hello Mumbai" dated 07.01.2023 and as the issue involved is in the interest of the public at large,

Commission decided to take up this matter as suo moto under Section 12 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993.

5. Hence, following order is passed:

- a) Office is directed to issue summons to the Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai calling upon him to file affidavit in reply before this Commission on or before 17.02.2023.
- b) Corporation is also directed to provide a copy of this order to Mr. Narendra Butola, President, Amrapali Griha Nirman Society informing him that if he want he can also file his say in the present matter.
- c) **Matter to appear on board before Court No.1 on 17th February 2023 at 11.00 a.m.**

City edition - Hello Mumbai of Marathi newspaper Lokmat dated 07.01.2023 highlighted apathy on the part of Corporation in tackling the issue of the nuisance created due to leakage from drainage, thereby causing not only inconvenience but, environmental hazards to the public / citizens living in the close vicinity. In view of the seriousness of the issue, suo motu cognizance came to be taken by the Commission and notices came to be issued to the stakeholder department. Interim reports on affidavit came to be submitted vide Ex. 'A' & Ex. 'B' and Ex. 'C'.

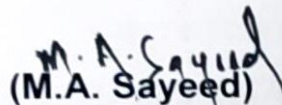
2. A specific statement on oath is made by the concerned officer vide Ex. 'C', asserting in para 7 that the issue highlighted in the news article came to be resolved by carrying out the work of sewerage line and of obtaining

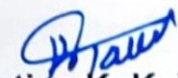
completion certificate from BMC. Copies of the relevant certificates and documents are annexed with the affidavit Ex. 'C'.
